ORDER

In Re: E-Filing System and E-Filing Procedures

The South Carolina Administrative Law Court (ALC), Office of Motor Vehicle Hearings (OMVH) created an E-Filing System for the electronic filing and exchange of documents with the Court. To implement the E-Filing System, the Court adopted OMVH E-Filing Procedures pursuant to Rule 4(D), OMVH on August 7, 2024. On February 5, 2025, the OMVH began allowing the voluntary usage of the E-Filing System for authorized attorneys. At that time, the Court also gave notice that e-filing would be required in the future for all filings in which the motorist was represented by an attorney. The Court has now determined that the use of the system should be mandatory for all attorneys consistent with the OMVH E-Filing Procedures. Accordingly, mandatory usage of the E-Filing System shall be required beginning on August 1, 2025.
