Can I talk to the Hearing Officer?

No party is allowed to speak to the Hearing Officer about the case without all the other parties being involved. Each Hearing Officer has a staff member who you can speak with to clarify procedural and scheduling matters and who can provide information from the case file (see contact information under the 'Contact Us' tab). However, no OMVH employee can give you any legal advice, and you should never attempt to discuss the facts of your case with any employee of the OMVH. Your opportunity to explain the facts of your case and your position is at the hearing.
